Amount

Up to two scholarships will be awarded in amounts of up to \$1500 each.

Eligibility

1. The applicant must be enrolled at any ABET accredited school in the state of Georgia.
2. The applicant must be an undergraduate who will be entering either the third or fourth year of a four-year program or the second year of a two-year program by the fall semester of the submission year. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student for the fall semester of the submission year.
3. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only once.
4. The applicant must submit a completed application and a copy of their college transcript. Resumes may also be included, but are not required.
