Malaika Rivers is responsible for leading the efforts of the Cumberland Community Improvement District (CID), located in the Cumberland submarket in northwest Atlanta, Georgia. The Cumberland CID is the mechanism by which the area's commercial property owners - the private sector - invest in public infrastructure to protect and increase their property values as well as better the entire community. Rivers began with the Cumberland CID in 1996. She has helped the business community leverage \$140 million into an estimated \$2.5 billion in capital improvements through this public-private partnership. Rivers sits on the Board of Directors for the Georgia Chamber of Commerce, Council for Quality Growth, and the Livable Communities Council. She is active with the Urban Land Institute and a member of Lambda Alpha International. She sits on various regional committees and is a graduate of the Regional Leadership Institute as well as Leadership Cobb. Rivers has also served as an appointment by the Speaker of the House of the Georgia House of Representatives. Prior to her current position, Rivers was with the Atlanta Regional Commission and before that, with private industry in Washington D.C. and Northern Virginia. Rivers is a graduate of Virginia Tech and lives in Atlanta, Georgia with her two children.
